The University

Pakistan's leading research-intensive university, LUMS is home to the most promising students for a lifetime of learning and leadership. LUMS offers undergraduate, graduate and doctoral programmes through its five schools: Suleman Dawood School of Business, Mushtaq Ahmad Gurmani School of Humanities and Social Sciences, Syed Babar Ali School of Science and Engineering, Shaikh Ahmad Hassan School of Law and Syed Ahsan Ali and Syed Maratib Ali School of Education.

Driven by a philosophy of 'Learning Without Borders' that breaks disciplinary boundaries and bridges the gap between theory and practice, LUMS is home to a dozen transdisciplinary centres. These centres engage faculty and students and collaborate with external institutions to address society's grand challenges.

With faculty that is dedicated to teaching and creation of knowledge, the University hosts an enriching and seamless experience through multidisciplinary research and teaching, emphasising integrative learning, critical thinking, and creative problem-solving.

Undergraduate Education

Excellence in teaching and learning is a cornerstone of the LUMS experience. Undergraduate education at LUMS comprises three essential features: the first is the university core courses that all LUMS undergraduates study because these courses cover learning considered essential for all students, irrespective of their school. Second, each student specialises in a major offered by their specific school to develop depth and expertise in one field of knowledge. Finally, students also take 'outgroups' – courses in fields different from their specialisation

- to acquire broad exposure to other fields of human knowledge.

These elements – common learning, depth in one field, and broad exposure outside one's specialisation – comprise the three essential features of an undergraduate education at LUMS. Over and above these requirements, students have the choice to consider optional curricular opportunities: free electives or minors (to explore any subject of their interest on campus, offered by any school), independent study (to learn 1-on-1 or in small groups with a faculty, focusing on a topic of their interest), semester abroad at an international university, senior projects, research and many other opportunities. The three requirements and this variety of additional choices can enable each student at LUMS to create a unique academic experience for themselves – a journey in 'Learning without Borders' that is supported by world-class faculty trained from universities around the world.

Student Life

There is always something happening at LUMS; from lively discussions between students and faculty, to student-led events, on campus and off. The classroom experience at LUMS is also a holistic one. Every lecture encourages exchange of ideas, creative freedom and intellectual growth, and students are actively involved in ground-breaking research.

The diverse and inclusive environment at LUMS fosters a strong sense of community, which makes for a dynamic university experience. Students can join any of the 55 student societies that organise events, competitions, seminars, camps, and conferences throughout the year. They can also



Not-for-Profit Status

LUMS is a federally chartered university and is approved as a not-for-profit organisation under section 2(36) of Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 in terms of provisions of Clause 63 of Part IV of Second Schedule to the Ordinance. Any individual or organisation making donations to LUMS is entitled to a tax credit under section 61 of Income Tax Ordinance, 2001. Moreover, the University has been granted exemption from the levy of income tax under Section 159 of the Ordinance, thus, tax is not deductible on payments made to the University.
